To complete the Master Builders Program and attain the Grand Master's Achievement Recognition Award the newly made Master Mason must satisfactorily complete Parts 1 and 2 through the Internet-based learning programs provided through the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania and fulfill mandatory and voluntary requirements of Part 3 within one year of being raised.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. Attend a stated meeting of your home lodge. _____
2. Attend an extra meeting of your home lodge. _____
3. Attend at least one meeting of another lodge in your district. _____
4. Serve as greeter for one of your lodge's stated meetings. _____
5. Attend an Official Visitation of the DDGM within your district. _____
6. Attend at least one of your lodge's fellowship events. _____
7. Attend a youth group meeting within your district or region. *
(In cases where a Masonic Youth group does not meet within a 50-mile radius, an additional voluntary component may be completed instead, subject to DDGM approval.)* _____
8. Assist with your Blue Lodge's Mentor Program as required by The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania's Education Committee. _____
9. Attend at least two (2) meetings of your district's School of Instruction. _____
10. Assist the Secretary or other members in contacting members in danger of being suspended to discuss with them what you believe to be the benefits of their Masonic membership. _____

FULFILL AT LEAST FOUR VOLUNTARY CRITERIA LISTED BELOW

1. Participate in a degree conferred by your lodge. _____
2. Be the first line signer on a petition for membership in your lodge. _____
3. Contact a brother who has not attended lodge in the last six months and invite him to accompany you to the next stated meeting. *(The brother must accept and attend in order for these criteria to be completed.)* _____
4. Assume responsibility for arranging a Masonic Education program for your lodge. This may be done by you or by someone else by your invitation with the Worshipful Master's approval. _____
5. Attend a quarterly communication of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania. _____
6. Attend either a stated meeting of The Pennsylvania Lodge of Research or the Academy of Masonic Knowledge. _____
7. Assist in a fund-raising event held by your lodge. _____
8. Attend and participate in a Masonic funeral service to honor a brother. _____
9. Memorize and recite at a lodge meeting, a part of Masonic ritual (opening or closing charge, degree charge, or prayer). _____
10. Participate as a member of the Committee of Inquiry for a petitioner. _____
11. Attend a meeting of a Sectional School of Instruction. _____
